#### Introduction

- ☐ Grant support from the U.S. State Department managed by Global Initiative for Fiscal Transparency (GIFT)
- Support from the World Bank and partners through the PFMRISP/IPFMRP II
  - To improve fiscal transparency and introduce public participation in the annual budget process
- How should it be done under the GIFT and WB Support Programme?
  - GOL to partnership with CSO and establish "Fiscal Transparency Advisory Group"
  - GOL adoption of Social Audit (recommended) as its Public Participation Mechanism

- ☐ Meets routinely and advise on implementation public participation mechanism
- ☐Advise on design and implementation
- □ Identify priority areas
- ☐ Review work plans
- ☐Close feedback loop

#### **Membership of the Advisory Group**

- □ Consist of equal representation of GOL and CSOs
  - Proposed Civil Society Organizations (CSOs)
  - Center for Transparency and Accountability in Liberia (CENTAL)
  - Institute for Research and Democratic Development (IREDD)
  - Women NGOs Secretariat of Liberia (WONGOSOL)
  - Center for Democratic Governance (CDG)
  - Community Development and Research Agency (CODRA)

#### Consist of equal representation of GOL and CSOs

- Government Representatives
- Ministry of Finance & Development Planning (MFDP)
- Public Procurement and Concession Commission (PPCC)
- General Auditing Commission (GAC)
- National Bureau of Concession (NBC)
- Liberia Extractive Transparency Initiative (LEITI)

- **☐** Budget Formulation Process (pilot in FY2023)
  - Attend SWG meetings at both technical and policy levels
  - Attend Executive Budget Hearings
  - Provide Expert Testimonies at Cabinet to inform policy choices
    - Could be limited during FY2021 due to COVID-19 restrictions
- Budget Approval Process
  - Attend public hearings on revenue and expenditure
  - Ask questions
  - Provide expert testimonies
- **☐** Budget Execution
  - Monitoring and tracking of revenue & public expenditures
  - Raising awareness on revenue generation

- □ Reporting/Audits (Evaluation)
  - Social audits (ideally FY2020/21)
  - Use of audit reports by GAC, with initial funding from GOL
    - Should not in any way compromise independence and objectivity
    - Demonstrates commitment to improving fiscal governance and responsiveness and increase public confidence and ownership
  - Findings/feedback should inform policy guidelines & strengthen implementation framework
- □ Access to Data/Information
  - GOL to provide unhindered access to information in keeping with the FOI Law
  - Such information will be identified and agreed upon during SWG meetings
  - Some data source may include Report of Past Budget Performance, SWG Strategy, BCC, BOP,
     BFP, Fiscal Outturn Reports, etc.
