This is usually coordinated by the Federal Ministry of Finance Budget and National Planning.

Objectives

- 1. Ensure Budget Policy Formulation and implementation is inclusive and based on needs assessment for national growth and development with active participation of key stakeholders and legislative oversight
- 2. To make available process, systems and structures for public participation
- 3. To ensure citizens participation, monitoring and evaluation of programs, projects through transparent and accountable feedback, deployment and use of e-budget implementation tracking portal
- 4. To ensure that citizens understand and are involved in budget planning and preparation
